Soar into the inspiring science and technology of flight at the Hiller Aviation Museum!

Nearly 150 years of aerospace technology is represented in the Museum's collection of 50 different aircraft, ranging from 19th-century gliders to modern research airplanes. Interactive exhibits and age-appropriate hands-on programs make the Hiller Aviation Museum an ideal field trip destination for students from pre-school through high school.



School Group Admission Policies

- Reservations are required at least two weeks in advance.
- Minimum group size 12 students, at least one adult per 8 students.
- School group admission fees Mon–Fri: \$4/child, \$8/adult (waived for 1 adult per 8 students).
- School group admission fees Sat–Sun: \$8/participant.
- Reservations secured by credit card payment due upon arrival.


Financial Assistance




