GRANT FUNDING APPLICATION
ADMISSION/PROGRAM FEE WAIVERS

For qualified schools serving low income students, field trip grants are available to waive admission/program fees up to 120 students and 15 adults (teachers, parents, chaperones) per school for in-person field trips visiting the Museum, or for Museum-provided distance learning programs, that take place between July 1st, 2021 and June 30th, 2022. Waiver awards include weekday admission to the Museum and, optionally, one hands-on or distance learning program from the following list:

In-Person Field Trips

Amazing Aircraft I – Eye on the Sky – Flight & Motion – Flight Simulator Lab

Distance Learning Programs

Helicopter Adventure – Flight Planning

Schools with at least 30% of students qualified to receive free or reduced price meals qualify for the admission waiver award. Awards will be made based on this criterion and on the availability of funding. All waivers must be redeemed no later than June 30th, 2022.
